Applying for a place

Dear pupils and parents,

Many thanks for your attendance at the information evening on Monday, and we hope it has both answered any questions you had and excited you about the prospect of the expedition!

To apply for a place on the expedition, please **sign and return the form below** to the black box marked 'Trips' at reception, together with a **cheque for £300** by way of deposit. Cheques should be made payable to 'KES Trips', and should be deposited by Thurs 30th April at the latest.

It must be stressed that as we have a limited number of places reserved for the expedition (and must retain discretion in our judgement of pupils' suitability for such a 'school trip'), a return does not mean a definite acceptance: confirmations will be sent as soon as is possible, at which time your cheque will be cashed. Early application is advised!

Once successful in your application, a third letter will be sent detailing the payment schedule and expected instalments: these can be made either on the 'School Gateway' system, via standing order or via larger BACS payments.

Lastly, one of our earliest meetings with the newly-formed expedition team will discuss money-making ideas for the expedition, so pupils are encouraged to explore their own opportunities for this as soon as possible.
